

## On studying the *PTC* course

There are no prior educational requirements for the *PTC* course. Generally, students should plan to spend at least five hours each week studying the subject in order to successfully complete it. Upon enrolment in the first subject, Moore College provides a very helpful 'How to Study' booklet, free of charge. In addition to private study, many people find it beneficial to complete the course as part of a study group.

Upon successful completion of the six (6) *PTC* subjects, Moore College awards the Preliminary Theological Certificate. Upon successful completion of a further two (2) diocesan-based subjects and annual participation in the Tasmanian Bible Forums, the Bishop of the Anglican Diocese of Tasmania awards a Certificate in Theology and Ministry. Where alternative assessment is successfully taken for the six *PTC* units and the rest of the Certificate program successfully completed, the Bishop will award a Certificate in Theology and Ministry.
